The fee rates for the academic year 2011/12 will be:

## Boarding Places

### Years 7 - 13:

**£8,335 per term**

The fee is inclusive of:

- Breakfast, lunch and supper during term time
- Provision of the Christ's Hospital Tudor-style uniform
- The cost of some compulsory educational trips or outings
- Hire of all text books up to GCSE and use of a school laptop in the Upper Sixth Form year.

The above fee is also charged for EU based families.  
For outside the EU, please contact Admissions.

## Day Places

### Years 7 and 8:

**£4,500 per term**

### Years 9 - 13:

**£5,665 per term**

The fee is inclusive of:

- Lunch and supper from Monday to Friday during term time
- Lunch only on Saturdays during term time
- Provision of the Christ's Hospital Tudor-style uniform
- The cost of some compulsory educational trips or outings
- Hire of all text books up to GCSE and use of a school laptop in the Upper Sixth Form year.
- If space permits, a Day pupil may opt to stay overnight at an additional fee for a maximum of 20 nights per term

## Parents are asked to pay for:

- Sportswear, casual wear, nightwear, underwear and shoes
- £20 per term for pocket money
- £25 per term for House Funds (which contributes towards treats and entertainment)
- A dictionary and a Bible
- Dry cleaning of the 'Bluecoat' Uniform
- Miscellaneous e.g. lost books, testing of personal electrical equipment
- Learning support. (please enquire)
- Music lessons (please enquire)

## Bursaries

The Christ's Hospital Foundation provides more bursarial support than any other independent boarding school with up to 100% support primarily to children of families in financial or other need.

If your income falls below a certain level, you may be assessed for a bursary which may cover the full cost of fees at the school. Bursaries are means-tested. Families on very low incomes may also be assisted with the cost of pocket money and House Funds. If you wish to apply for a bursary, please contact Admissions.

## Scholarships

Scholarships are awarded for academic excellence, and separately for and ability in music, art, drama and sport. They are awarded as a result of entrance assessments carried out by us. The maximum value of these awards is 20%. Please tick the box to provide us with an indication of your interest in a scholarship.

## Registration Fee and Deposit

There is a non-refundable registration fee of £50, payable with the registration form for both Day and Boarding places and a deposit of up to £800 (reduced for those on bursaries), payable on successful completion of the assessments and refundable against the final bill after leaving the School.

For entrants from outside the EU, a deposit of a full term's fee is required, payable on completion of the assessments and refundable against the final bill after leaving the school.

If having accepted a place you withdraw your child before entry, you will become liable to pay a term's contribution in lieu of notice.

## Sibling Discounts

Sibling discounts are discretionary for those on bursaries, recognising the impact on family income of fees paid for the first child. If paying full fees, sibling discounts are fixed at 8% for the second child and 10% for the third child in the school.

## Payment of Fees

Payment of fees is divided into three equal instalments, due prior to the start of each term and will be collected by direct debit.

Fee rates are reviewed annually.
