



## The fee rates for the academic year 2019/20 will be:

### Years 7 - 13:

£12,630 per term

The fee is inclusive of:

- 2 x 30 minute tutorials in English as a Second Language per week
- Support from the International Co-ordinator
- Breakfast, lunch and supper during term time
- Provision of the Christ's Hospital Tudor-style uniform
- The cost of some educational trips or outings
- Hire of all text books up to GCSE

### Parents are asked to pay for:

- Transfers from Heathrow and Gatwick
- Staying at school over leave-weekends (from £100 per weekend)
- Provision of goods and services ordered when joining e.g. bedding, labelling etc.
- Sportswear, casual wear, nightwear, underwear and shoes
- Pocket money (£30 per term is recommended)
- £35 per term for House Funds which contributes towards treats and entertainment
- A dictionary and a Bible
- Dry cleaning of the uniform
- Miscellaneous e.g. lost books, testing of personal electrical equipment
- Learning support (please enquire)
- Music lessons (please enquire)
- Some broader curricular activities

### SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are awarded for academic excellence and for outstanding ability in music, art, drama and sport. The awards are offered to pupils at 13+ and Sixth Form.

### SIBLING DISCOUNTS

Sibling discounts are 8% for the second child and 10% for the third child in the school.

### REGISTRATION FEE AND DEPOSIT

There is a non-refundable registration fee of £65 payable with the registration form and a deposit of a term's fees, payable on successful completion of the assessments and refundable against the final bill after leaving Christ's Hospital.

If, having accepted a place, you withdraw your child before entry, you will become liable to pay a term's fees in lieu of notice.

### PAYMENT OF FEES

Invoices are raised termly and should be paid by bank draft or electronic transfer before the start of each term.
