Old Blues Day – Market Stallholder information and T's and C's

- There will be a non-refundable charge of £15 to secure a stall; this will be requested one month prior to the day.
- Stallholders will be responsible for the setting up and clearing away of their stalls – tables and chairs will be supplied.
- Stalls will be placed on the front lawns of some of the Avenue Boarding Houses and will be open to the elements. In the case of severe wet or windy weather we will relocate to either the Cloisters or the Mellstrom Centre.
- There will be no electrical output available for the stalls.
- There will be a limited number of stalls available and these will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

T's and C's

- No stall selling products that contain, or are tobacco or alcohol based, will be considered.
- No stall offering black henna tattoos will be considered.
- Soap and cosmetic sellers must ensure that their products are compliant with the EU Cosmetic Regulation 1223/2009.
- Depending on the nature of a food based enterprise, we may require stallholders to provide evidence of a Food Hygiene Rating of 4 or above; this will be requested if deemed appropriate. If you are a food business that is required to register with your local authority, you must ensure that any food stuffs have the required food allergen labelling, and we strongly recommend that allergen details are made available or labelled by anyone making foodstuff products.
- Depending on the nature of the products being sold we may require stallholders to hold their own public and/or product liability insurance; these will be requested if deemed necessary.
- Closing date for stallholder applications will be 17 April 2020.
