Sibling discounts are 8% for the second child and 10% for the third child in the school.

REGISTRATION FEE AND DEPOSIT

There is a non-refundable registration fee of £150 payable with the registration form and a deposit of a term's fees, payable on successful completion of the assessments and refundable against the final bill after leaving Christ's Hospital.

If, having accepted a place, you withdraw your child before entry, you will become liable to pay a term's fees in lieu of notice.
