**Tickets:** Tickets can be paid for by cash or VISA/ Mastercard. All tickets are non refundable.

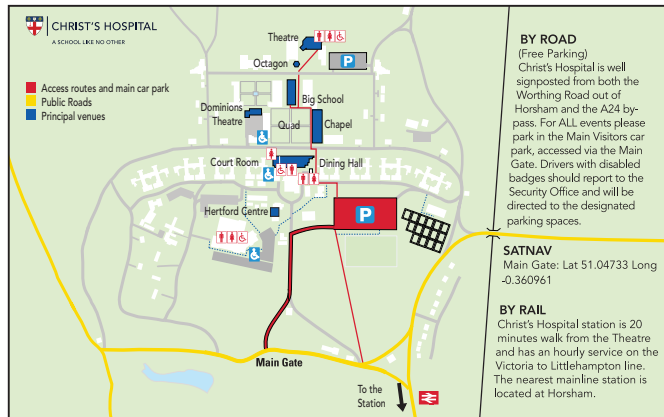
